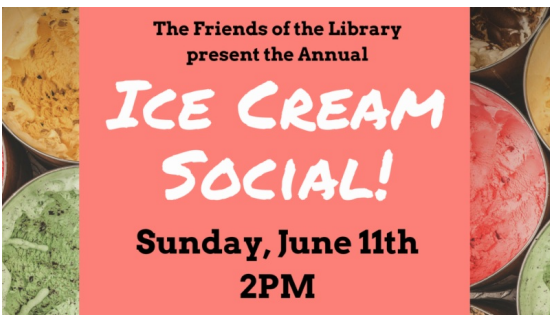

All are welcome to attend one of our monthly book discussion groups. Copies of the books are available at the circulation desk.

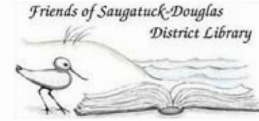
The Afternoon Book Discussion will meet at the Old School House on Tuesday, June 13th at 4pm.
