# **New Building Proposal**



The Library board is proposing a new 9,000 sq. ft. building to be constructed on the vacant lot on the north side of Center Street in Douglas, which was purchased by the Library in 2014. If the recommended bond issue is passed, the project will cost \$4.35 million, with a rate of .4271 mills.

### Why Do We Need a New Building?

- Too many stairs and an unreliable, uncomfortably small elevator
- Not enough space for books and DVDs
- Only one bathroom
- Flooding in the Children's Room
- Lack of quiet areas
- No designated space for library programs or staff work areas
- Inefficient HVAC
- Maxed out electrical capacity

- Space for 25% more books and DVDs
- Single story, ADA compliant
- Multi-functional space for library programs and community use
- Quiet reading areas
- Multiple restrooms
- Small group meeting room
- Modern infrastructure
