LIBRARY CARD POLICY

Who Can Get a Card

Residents of the City of Saugatuck, the City of the Village of Douglas and Saugatuck Township are eligible for a Saugatuck-Douglas District Library card. This card is valid at all <u>Lakeland Library</u> <u>Cooperative</u> member libraries, according to their policies and restrictions.

How to Get Your Card

Bring your driver's license to the Library and fill out a registration form. If your local address is not on your license, please also bring official documentation that attaches you to property in the area (utility bills, tax bills, etc.). Children under the age of 18 are required to have a parent or legal guardian co-sign their registration form. Both parent and child must be present at the time of registration.

Non-Resident/Local Use Only Cards

Visitors and temporary residents who do not own property, may purchase a card for a quarterly fee of \$10. These cards are for use at the Saugatuck-Douglas District Library *ONLY* and do *NOT* entitle the cardholder to reciprocal borrowing at other Lakeland Libraries. Proper identification and proof-of-address must be presented to purchase a non-resident card.
