Join us at the Library for this fun program! Learn how to make a rose out of fondant and create your own unicorn cupcake with help from local baker, Lisa Schulz.

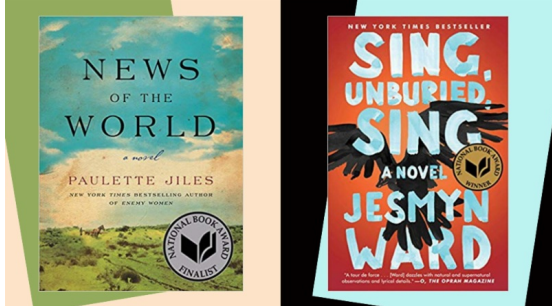
