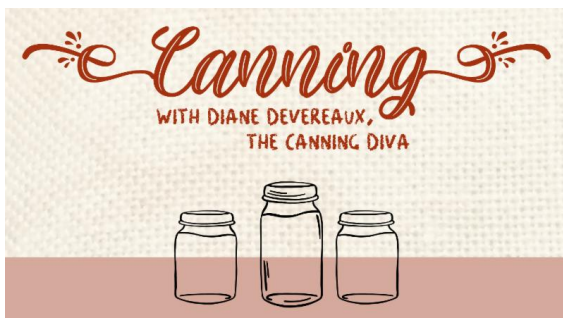

Construction on the new building will begin in the spring of 2019.
